CIC On the Road: Parish Partnership Overview

CIC Responsibilities

Program Design & Facilitation

- Facilitate the program, including all content, structure, and flow.
- Provide a trained facilitator (staff or guest presenter) to guide the experience.

Promotional Materials

- Supply digital and print-ready promotional assets (flyer, social media graphics, event description).
- Provide suggested language for parish bulletins, newsletters, and announcements.

Registration Support (if applicable)

- Offer optional online registration platform if the parish prefers CIC to manage RSVPs.
- Share attendance tracking tools or templates if registration is managed locally.

Spiritual Resources

- Provide handouts or take-home materials to support continued reflection after the event.
- Offer follow-up resources or suggestions for further spiritual growth.

Host Parish Responsibilities

Venue & Hospitality

- Provide a quiet, welcoming space suitable for prayer and reflection.
- Ensure seating, lighting, and sound are conducive to a contemplative atmosphere.
- Assign a parish contact to coordinate logistics with CIC staff.

Local Promotion

- Promote the event within the community using CIC-provided materials.
- Encourage parish groups (e.g., adult faith formation, prayer groups) to attend.

Onsite Support

- Welcome attendees and assist with check-in (if applicable).
- Provide basic hospitality (e.g., greeters, coffee/tea/water station, signage).
- Ensure AV equipment is available and functioning if needed (e.g., microphone, music playback).

Follow-Up Engagement

- Share CIC's follow-up resources with attendees.
- Consider offering a parish-based continuation (e.g., silent prayer group, Lenten reflection series).
